

Organic Feta Happy Days Dairy Salmon Arm, BC happydaysdairy.com	Donat Koller grew up in Switzerland on a small dairy farm. After studying cheese making and working on various farms, he immigrated to Canada in 1993 and founded Happy Days Dairy. The organic cow milk for all their cheese comes from the McLeod family farm where the animals pasture at the foot of Mount Ida, in the Shuswap. Hand made in small batches, the Organic Feta is fresh and bright with a tangy zest on the palate and salty finish.
Le Baluchon Fromagerie F.X. Pichet Sainte-Anne de la Pérade, QC fromageriefxpichet.com	This unique farmstead organic cheese is hand crafted bearing a golden washed rind and pale yellow interior. The distinctive meaty aroma and rich lingering flavour are partly the result of the organic thermalized milk from select herds of Brown Swiss and pure bred Holstein cows that graze in the pastures near the cheese plant. Michel Pichet has been farming organically for over 25 years.
King Cole Upper Bench Creamery Penticton, BC upperbench.ca	Owner Shana Miller named this cheese after her East Coast family. As its name suggests, King Cole is made in large 6kg wheels and aged for 6 to 8 weeks. This semi-soft surface ripened blue has beautiful veining on the interior creating the bold full flavour with hints of apple and pear on the finish.
